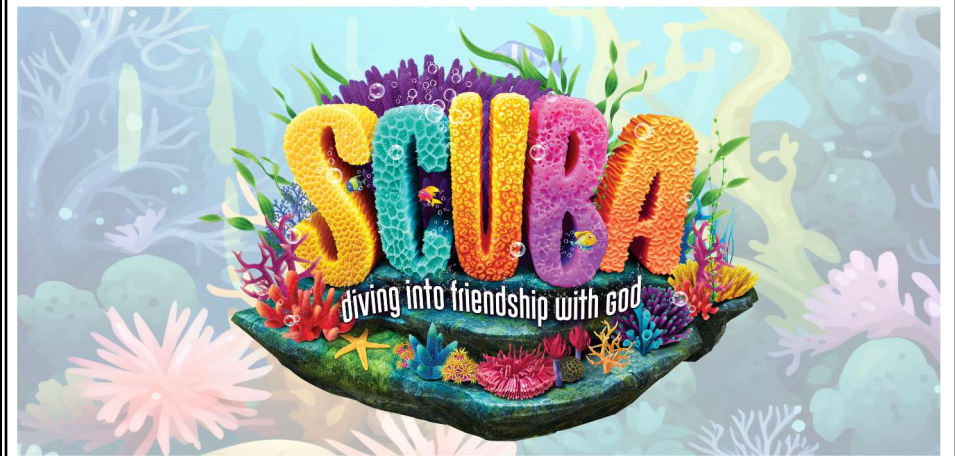

The Nursery

2. Staffed nursery in lower level.
