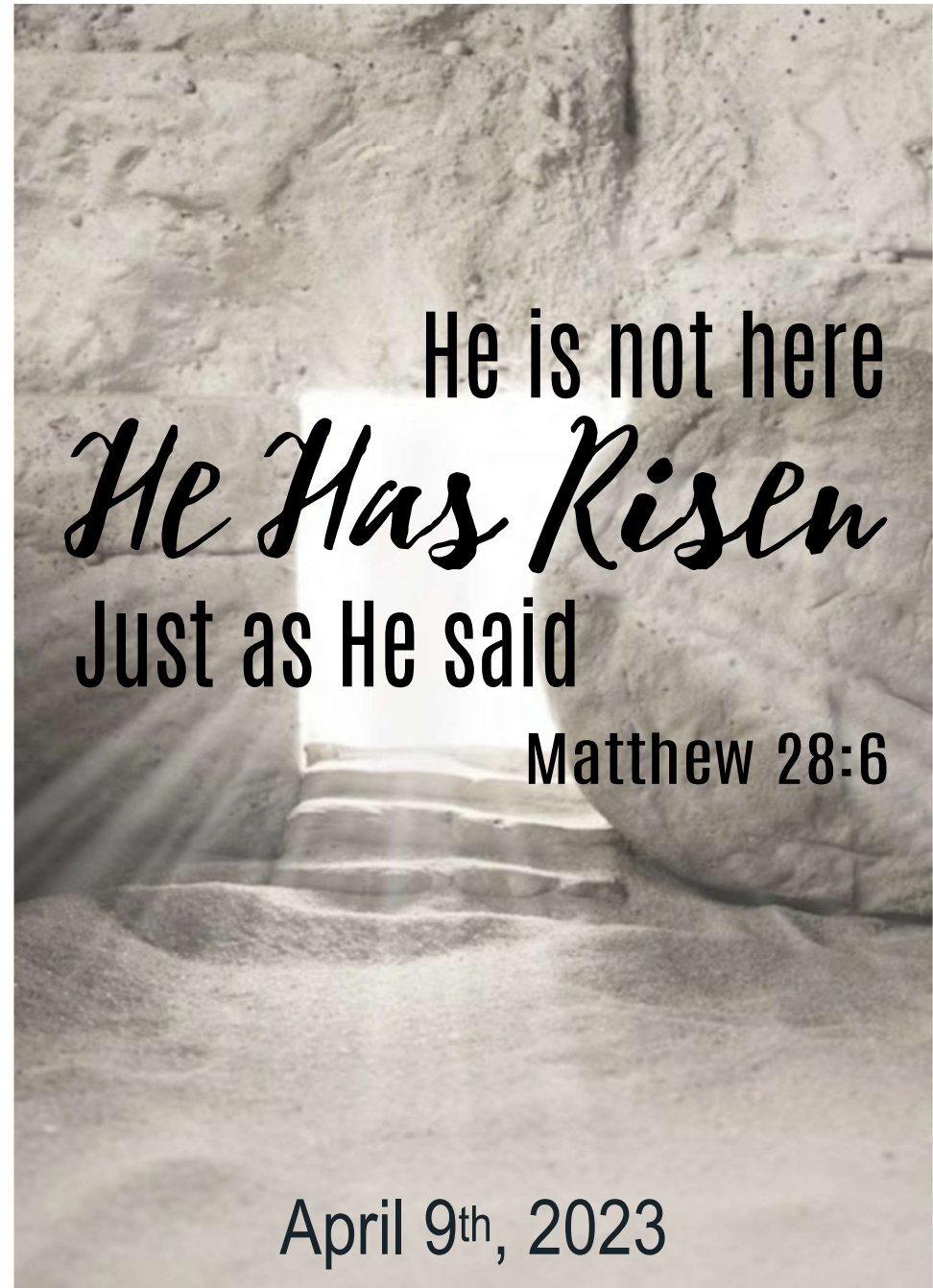

# He Has Risen!

Those words were first spoken by the angel at the empty tomb of Jesus, and then were repeated by the women who heard them, and later the disciples, and finally by all who saw the risen Christ. With these words, they gave testimony to what had occurred on that first resurrection morning. Eventually "He has Risen" (emphasizing the event) or "He Is Risen" (emphasizing that He is still alive) became a greeting among Christians on Easter Sunday around the world. Lia Martin from iBelieve writes, "the phrase 'He is risen indeed' is actually a response that is part of a paschal greeting exchanged on Easter Sunday, primarily in Orthodox churches..." However and wherever it is spoken, with or without the response, it is an expression of the truth that Jesus has paid for our sins, and has defeated death by rising from the dead. Beyond that, He is alive today, and invites us to know Him and follow Him, until the day we go to be with Him, or He comes back for His church. May the truth of those words ever encourage our hearts, and be the message we live and share.
