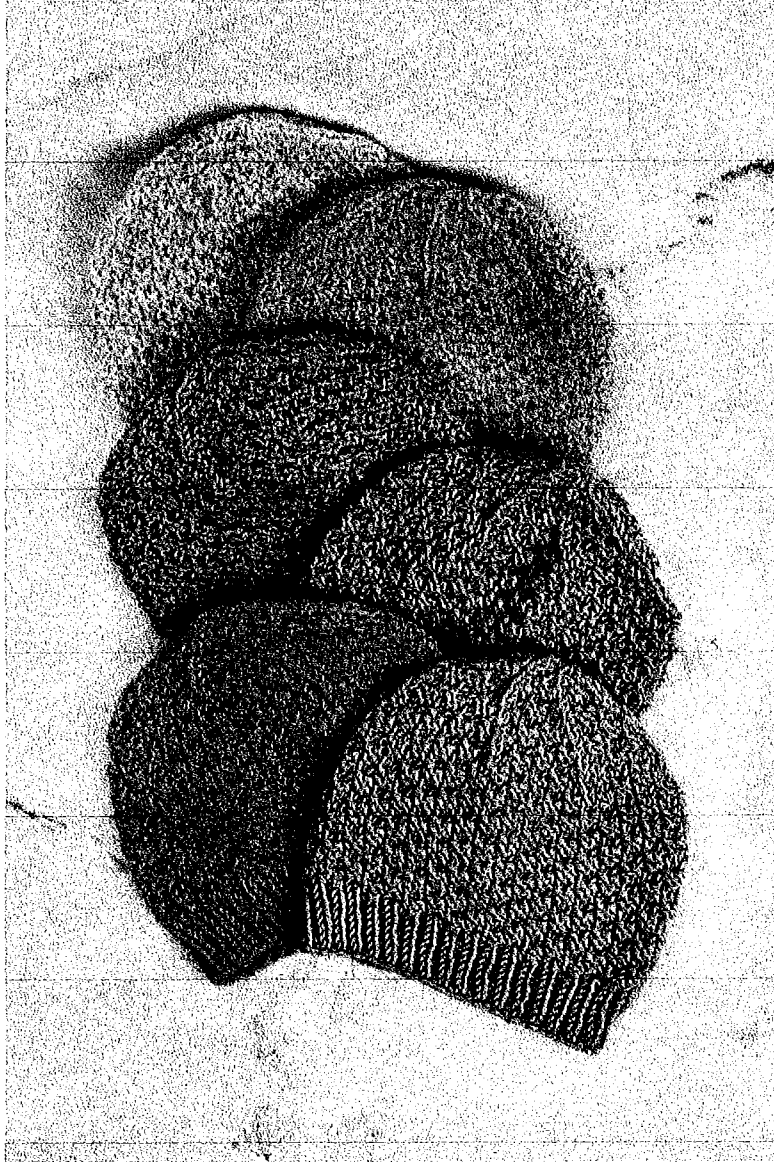

SKILL

Knitting

DIFFICULTY

Easy

SIZES

Newborn (3 mos., 6-12 mos., 12-24 mos.)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Brim Circumference: 11 (12½, 13¾, 15¼)"

Length: 5¾ (6, 7, 8)"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Uptown Bamboo DK*
(80% Anti-Pilling Acrylic, 20% bamboo;
100g/284 yds)

- Any color - 1 skein

Needles: US Size 6 (4 mm) set of DPNs
(or your preferred ndl for knitting small
circumferences) *or size needed to obtain
gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

22 sts x 28 rnds = 4" in Double Moss
Stitch

Save time, check your gauge.

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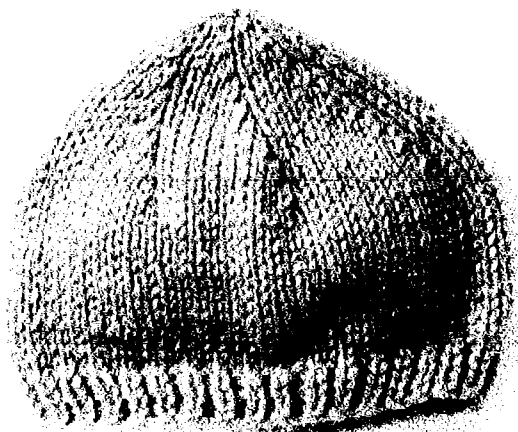

BEGINNER

SIZES

Preemie 3-4 lbs (Preemie 5-6 lbs - Newborn 7-9 lbs-3 months 10-12 lbs).

To fit head circumference:

8½ (11-12½-14)" [21.5 (28-32-35.5) cm].

GAUGE

20 stitches and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. For ease in working, circle all numbers pertaining to your size.

Cast on 43 (49-61-71) stitches (sts).

1st row: [Right Side (RS)]. *Knit 1 (K1). Purl 1 (P1). Repeat (Rep) from * to last st. K1.

2nd row: *P1. K1. Rep from * to last st. P1. Rep last 2 rows (K1. P1) ribbing once more.

Beginning (Beg) on a knit row, work in stocking st until Hat from beg measures approximately 1¾ (2¼-2¾-3)" [4.5 (5.5-7-7.5) 4.5 (5.5-7-7.5) cm], ending on a purl row.

Shape top: 1st row: (RS). K1. *Knit next 2 sts together (K2tog). K4 (5-8-8). Rep from * 6 (5-5-6) times more. 36 (43-55-64) sts.

2nd and alternate (alt) rows: Purl.
3rd row: K1. *K2tog. K3 (5-7-7). Rep from * 6 (5-5-6) times more. 29 (37-49-57) sts.

5th row: K1. *K2tog. K2 (4-6-6). Rep from * 6 (5-5-6) times more. 22 (31-43-50) sts.

7th row: K1. *K2tog. K1 (3-5-5). Rep from * 6 (5-5-6) times more. 15 (25-37-43) sts.

Sizes 5-6, 7-9 and 10-12 lbs only:
8th row: Purl.

9th row: K1. *K2tog. K (2-4-4). Rep from * (5-5-6) times more. (19-31-37) sts.
10th row: Purl.

11th row: K1. *K2tog. K (1-3-3). Rep from * (5-5-6) times more. (13-25-30) sts.

Sizes 7-9 and 10-12 lbs only: 12th row: Purl.

13th row: K1. *K2tog. K2. Rep from * (5-6) times more. (19-23) sts.

14th row: Purl.

15th row: K1. *K2tog. K1. Rep from * (5-6) times more. (13-16) sts.

All sizes: Next row: Purl.
Next row: *K2tog. Rep from * to last 1 (1-1-0) st(s). K1 (1-1-0). 8 (7-7-8) sts. Break yarn, leaving a long end. Draw end tightly through remaining (rem) sts and fasten securely. Sew center back seam.

MATERIALS

Caron® Simply Soft® (6 oz/170.1 g; 315 yds/288 m)

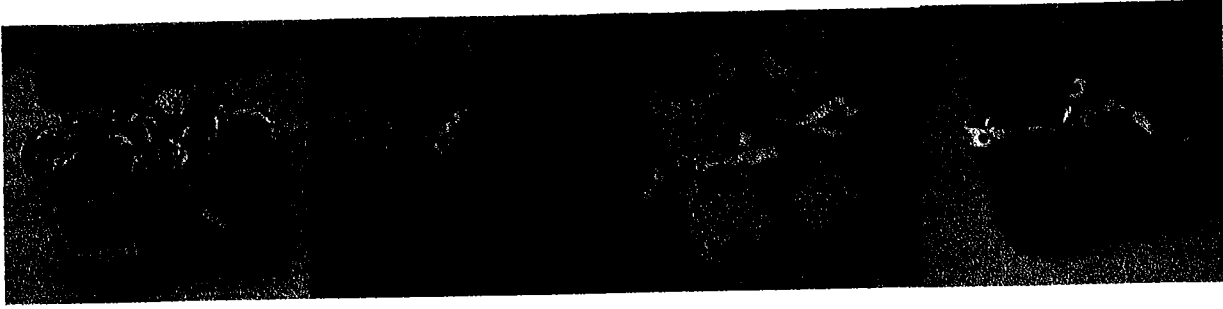
Sizes	3-4	5-6	7-9	10-12	pounds
Strawberry (0015)	1	1	1	1	ball

Note: 1 ball will make approximately 15 (12-8-6) Hats.

Size U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.

ABBREVIATIONS: www.yarnspirations.com/abbreviations

Alt = Alternate	K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together	Rep = Repeat
Beg = Begin(ning)	P = Purl	RS = Right side
K = Knit	Rem = Remain(ing)	St(s) = Stitch(es)



Pretty Simple Bootees

This pattern is adapted from several different patterns so that I could get the exact shape and size that I wanted. For best results use Debbie Bliss Baby Cashmerino yarn to make 0-3 months size. If you wish to make a larger size you could use a DK yarn on larger needles.

Abbreviations:

K = Knit

P = Purl

K2 tog = Knit 2 stitches together

P2 tog = Purl 2 stitches together

YO = Yarn Over (or yarn round needle if you prefer)

Sl1 = Slip stitch onto needle without knitting it

PSSO = Pass Slipped Stitch Over the stitch you have just knitted

Materials :-

1 x 50g ball of yarn (bootees will use approximately 25g)

1 pair of 3.25mm/US size 3 needles

1 metre/yard of ribbon (you can also make an i-cord or crochet chain)

Instructions :- (Make two)

Cast on 31 stitches and knit one row

Row 2: Knit 1, YO, Knit 14, YO, Knit 1, YO, Knit 14, YO, Knit 1 – 35sts

Row 3: Knit. When you reach the YO stitches for best results knit into back of stitch

Row 4: Knit 2, YO, Knit 14, YO, Knit 3, YO, Knit 14, YO, Knit 2 – 39sts

PATTERN NOTES

The perfect little topper for your perfect little human - the Candy Cap is an adorable little beanie made using just one skein of our baby-friendly Uptown Bamboo DK. It'll fly off your needles so quick; you'll want one in every color!

This hat is knit in the round from the bottom up.

STITCH GUIDE

Double Moss Stitch

(multiple of 4 sts)

Rnds 1-2: * K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rnds 3-4: * P2, k2; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnds 1-4 for patt.

K1, P1 Rib

(multiple of 2 sts)

Rnd 1: * K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

PATTERN BEGINS

HAT

Brim

Cast on 60 (68, 76, 84) sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

Work in K1, P1 Rib until piece meas approx. 1" from cast-on edge.

Main Hat

Work in Double Moss Stitch until piece meas approx. 3½ (3¾, 4, 4½)" from cast-on edge, ending with Rnd 3 (2, 2, 3) of patt.

Size 3 mo. ONLY:

Dec Rnd: P2, k2tog, cont in patt as est'd over 30 sts, k2tog, * p2, k2; rep from * to end - 2 sts dec'd, 66 sts rem.

Size 6-12 mo. ONLY:

Dec Rnd: P2, k2tog, [cont in patt. as est'd over 14 sts, k2tog] 3 times, * p2, k2; rep from * to end - 4 sts dec'd, 72 sts rem.

All Sizes:

60 (66, 72, 84) sts.

Crown Shaping

Set-up Rnd: * Cont in patt as est'd over 10 (11, 12, 14) sts, pm; rep from * to end - 5 markers placed across rnd (excluding bor marker).

Rnd 1 (Dec Rnd): * Cont as est'd to 2 sts bef m, k2tog; rep from * to end - 6 sts dec'd, 54 (60, 66, 78) sts rem.

Rnd 2: Cont in patt as est'd to end.

Rep Rnds 1-2, 7 (8, 9, 11) more times - 42 (48, 54, 66) sts dec'd, 12 sts rem across all sizes.

Break yarn leaving approx. 8" tail. Thread through rem live sts and pull taut to close.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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Row 5: Knit. When you reach the YO stitches for best results knit into back of stitch

Row 6: Knit 3, YO, Knit 14, YO, Knit 5, YO, Knit 14, YO, Knit 3 – 43sts

Row 7: Knit. When you reach the YO stitches for best results knit into back of stitch

Row 8: Knit 4, YO, Knit 14, YO, Knit 7, YO, Knit 14, YO, Knit 4– 47sts

Row 9: Knit. When you reach the YO stitches for best results knit into back of stitch

Row 10: Knit

Row 11: Purl

Repeat **Rows 10 and 11** three more times (a total of **8** rows).

Work Instep

Row 18: Knit 27, Sl1, K1, PSSO and turn your work

Row 19: Purl 8, P2 tog and turn work

Row 20: Knit 8, Sl1, K1, PSSO and turn work

Row 21: Purl 8, P2 tog and turn work

Row 22: Knit 8, Sl1, K1, PSSO and turn work

Row 23: Purl 8, P2 tog and turn work

Row 24: Knit 8, Sl1, K1, PSSO and turn work

Row 25: Purl 8, P2 tog and turn work

Row 26: Knit 8, Sl1, K1, PSSO and turn work

Row 27: Purl 8, P2 tog and turn work

Row 28: Knit 8, Sl1, K1, PSSO and turn work

Row 29: Purl 8, P2 tog and turn work

Row 30: Knit 8, Sl1, K1, PSSO and turn work

Row 31: Purl 8, P2 tog and turn work

Row 32: Knit 8, Sl1, K1, PSSO and knit last 11 stitches to end of row

Row 33: Purl 19, P2 tog and purl to end of row - **31sts**

Row 34: Knit

Row 35: Knit

Row 36: (Eyelet row) K1, *YO, K2 tog* repeat to last 2 sts, K2

Row 37: Knit

Row 38: Knit

Row 39: Purl

Row 40: Knit

Row 41: Purl

Row 42: Knit

Row 43: Purl

Row 44: Knit

Row 45: Purl

Rows 46 – 51 knit every row (6 rows)

Bind off all stitches.

To make up, stitch along seam from toe to cuff
