

Hebrews 3:1-6 “Jesus is Greater than Moses”

### ***Icebreaker***

Have you ever trusted someone in a position of leadership or authority, only to later realize their limitations? What made you trust them, and what changed your perspective?

**Read:** Hebrews 3:1-6

### **Key Theme**

Jesus is the ultimate and faithful representative of God, worthy of far greater glory than Moses. While Moses served faithfully within God’s house as a servant, Jesus rules over God’s house as the Son. Believers are identified as God’s house, but this identity is evidenced by holding firmly to our confidence and hope in Christ. The passage calls us to fix our thoughts on Jesus, recognizing His supremacy and remaining steadfast in faith.

### **Discussion Questions**

- 1. How does the description of holy brothers/sisters challenge our thinking about our church family? What are some ways that you serve the family of God?**
- 2. What does it mean for Jesus to be our High Priest? How does this apply to our lives?**
- 3. What does holiness look like for followers of Jesus?**
- 4. What are the most prominent things that the world is telling you to consider instead of Christ? What are some helpful ways that we can daily fix our mind on Christ?**
- 5. In what ways is Jesus superior to Moses? Include John 1:14-17 in this discussion.**

6. Both Moses and Jesus were faithful examples....what does faithfulness look like in our lives today?
  
7. What does it mean for Christ to be the builder of the house? What roles are contrast between Moses and Jesus? What is our role?
  
8. What does holding on to our confidence and boasting in our hope look like from day to day? How does the author encourage us to solidify our hope in Christ and in his work for our salvation?

### Takeaway

Because Jesus is greater than Moses:

- He is the Son over God's house, not merely a servant within it
- He is the builder and creator of all things
- He perfectly represents God to us and us before God
- He is worthy of our full attention, trust, and worship
- We are His people if we hold firmly to our confidence and hope in Him

***The gospel reminds us that our faith is not built on a servant, but on the Son. Jesus is supreme over all, and our security is found in steadfastly trusting Him.***

### Prayer
